

AIRPORT & GROUND TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

The Westin Playa Bonita is approximately a 40-minute drive (13.7 miles) from Tocumen International Airport (airport code PTY).

Hotel's Private Taxi The Westin Playa Bonita has its own private taxis that you may book for airport transportation. The current flat rate is \$45 USD from Tocumen International Airport to the Westin and \$42 USD from the Westin to the airport. Tipping is not customary, but it's good to round up the fare for good service. You may book the hotel taxis in advance through the hotel concierge at conciergew@westinplayabonita.com. You may pay the taxi drivers directly in cash only (no credit cards), or you could have the taxi charge added to your guest room folio. You may also request these taxis at the concierge desk to get to restaurants and local

City Taxis Licensed, registered taxis in Panama are yellow, and have plate numbers replicated on the sides of the vehicle. They do not have meters, and instead calculate fares based on how many zones are traversed. White unmarked vehicles known as "tourism taxis" operate out of airports, charging slightly more for private transportation.

Tourism (White) Taxis from Airport One-way taxi fare between the airport and Westin Playa Bonita is approximately \$40-50 USD. Be sure to use these white taxis (official tourist taxis) and confirm the price of your ride before you depart the airport. Taxis do not use meters and they do NOT accept credit cards – they only accept cash (USD). Tipping is not customary, but it's good to round up the fare for good service. After you pick up your luggage, you will find the white tourist taxis outside the exit

Private Transfers with Panamazing Panamazing, the hotel's in-house destination management company, offers private transportation between the airport, Westin Playa Bonita, and Gamboa Rainforest Resort (for those doing a pre or post stay there). They are offering the ISHRS a 5% discount which is reflected in the pricing on our group link which you can access by clicking this link: https://www.panamazing.com/ishrs/

Uber Uber is widely used in Panama City and serves the airport.

WEATHER

In October the temperature is generally between 77°F and 86°F (25°C and 30°C).

Located in the tropics, Panama has just two seasons: the dry season that runs from December to March and the much longer wet season that lasts from mid-March to December. During the wet season the rains usually only come for a short burst in the afternoon, which is typical for rainforest. It will be humid. The Westin Playa Bonita has umbrellas available by the exits.

There are approximately 12 hours of daylight.

MEETING ATTIRE (In-Person only)

The attire for the educational sessions is business. Attire for the gala is formal/ black tie (evening gowns and suits/tuxedos). Those attending the carnaval themed gala on Saturday evening are encouraged to wear bright clothing, sequins, or other festive formalwear.

BADGES

An official ISHRS-issued badge for the 30th World Congress is required to enter the World Congress. Alterations and tampering with badges is prohibited and subject to the No Badge Swapping Policy.

BADGE REPRINT POLICY

A penalty fee of \$25 USD will be charged for the first reprint of lost or misplaced badges. A second reprint will incur a penalty fee of \$100 USD. Badges will not be printed a third time.

NO BADGE SWAPPING POLICY

You may not swap badges with other persons. Badges are issued to individuals for that individual's use, and only that individual's use. Replacement badges using another name or badge swapping is prohibited. Unauthorized use of Congress badges shall be subject to a \$2,000 USD fine per violation and punitive action by the Board of Governors, up to and including Congress ejection or possible forfeiture of ISHRS membership.

Claire Higgins, PhD



Lecturer in Tissue Engineering and Regenerative Medicine, Department of Bioengineering, Imperial College London, London, United Kingdom

Dr. Claire Higgins was appointed as a Lecturer in the Department of Bioengineering at Imperial College London in April 2014, after postdoctoral training in the laboratory of Prof. Angela Christiano, in the Department of Dermatology, at Columbia University

in New York. At Columbia she received a Career Development Award from the Dermatology Foundation to research the 'Molecular basis of human hair follicle induction'. Claire obtained a Ph.D. in Skin Developmental Biology from Durham University in 2007, and holds a B.Sc. in Natural Sciences.

The main focus of her research group is to understand mechanisms of tissue development, and regeneration, both in normal conditions and in response to trauma. The hair follicle is used as a model, as it is an accessible and elegant system to study organ regeneration. Research into developmental, and regenerative processes means we can try and recreate them in a lab setting, and exploit the inherent properties of interacting cells to engineer new tissues and structures. Work in the group is funded by the Medical Research Council (MRC), the Engineering and Physical Sciences Research Council (EPSRC), and the British Skin Foundation (BSF).

He was invited onto the inaugural Board of ISHRS,

was Program Chair in 1996, President of ISHRS in 1997 and served as co-editor of the Forum 1998-2001. He was awarded the Gold Follicle in 2000 and the Manfred Lucas Award in 2014.

Juanita J. Anders, PhD



Professor, Department of Anatomy, Physiology and Genetics, Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences (USUHS)

Juanita J. Anders, PhD, is a Professor of Anatomy, Physiology and Genetics and Professor of Neuroscience, at Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. Professor Anders is an internationally recognized expert in

Photobiomodulation (PBM) research and has served as invited Chair and speaker globally. Her specialty is nervous system injury and repair mechanisms, pain modulation using PBM and light/tissue interactions. Dr. Anders received her PhD in Anatomy from the University of Maryland Medical School then joined the National Institutes of Health in the Laboratory of Neuropathology and Neuroanatomical Sciences, NINDS. Currently she is funded by the US Department of Defense to investigate the use PBM Therapy as a non-invasive, non-pharmaceutical alternative for the management of neuropathic pain.

Professor Anders has served and continues to serve as a member of numerous state, national, and international scientific review panels including the National Institutes of Health, the Food and Drug Administration, Veterans Affairs, the Department of Defense, and the Congressionally Directed Medical Research Programs. She also serves on the Executive Councils and Scientific Advisory Boards of numerous international laser conferences. She is the past president of the North American Association of Laser Therapy, a founding member of the International Academy of Laser Medicine and Surgery, Past President of the American Society of Lasers in Medicine and Surgery and Past Director of the Optical Society of America Photobiomodulation Technical Group. She has recently been appointed as a board member of the International Society of Lasers in Medicine and Surgery and currently serves on the Advisory Board of the Optica Photobiomodulation Technical Group. She is a Senior Editor of Photobiomodulation, Photomedicine and Laser Surgery, Associate Editor of Lasers in Medical Science, and Frontiers in Neuroscience (Neurogenesis) and on the editorial board of Physiotherapy Practice and Research and Laser Therapy. She has published over 70 peer reviewed articles.

Follicle Award in 1998 and the Manfred Lucas award in 2012. He was President of ISHRS in 2000.

NORWOOD LECTURER

Thomas L. Dawson, Jr., PhD



Agency for Science, Technology, and Research (A*STAR) Institute for Medical Biology

Dr. Dawson is a Senior Principal Investigator at the Agency for Science, Technology, and Research (A*STAR) Institute for Medical Biology (IMB) in Singapore. He is a research scientist and author on more than 50 original articles, book chapters, papers and other scientific communications, including

authoring the Dandruff and Hair Growth chapters of Cosmetic Dermatology for several editions. While at the Procter & Gamble Co. Dr. Dawson's research team discovered the fungal cause of dandruff and seborrheic dermatitis, identified the key microbes, Malassezia, and discovered and launched new technology in Head & Shoulders (the worlds largest shampoo brand). He also leads the Malassezia Research Consortium, a global multi-disciplinary collaboration on Malassezia biology, genomics, and pathogenicity.

Dr Dawson's hair and scalp research is focused on stopping or reversing changes in women's hair with age and menopause, via intervention in the metabolism and function of anagen hair follicles. A recent hair biology advance led to development of a successful in-market technology which improves the diameter of women's scalp hair.

Dr. Dawson was recognized with the "John Smale" award as Procter & Gamble's top technologist in 2002, and he is appointed to the faculty of Miami University (Ohio) Department of Botany as Adjunct Assistant Professor and the Department of Biochemistry and Drug Discovery at the Medical University of South Carolina as an Adjunct Professor. Prior to joining A*STAR IMB Dr. Dawson was a Senior Principal Investigator at the Procter & Gamble Co. where he led the Life Sciences Innovation team for the Singapore Innovation Center. He was a Fellow in Pediatrics with Duke University Medical Center and investigated genetic metabolic disease, including development of a Pompe Disease treatment (Myozyme). He earned his Ph.D. at the Lineberger Cancer Center at UNC-CH, where he studied breast cancer, a novel human protoncogene, c-mer; and ROS in orthotopic liver transplantation. Dr. Dawson grew up in WV and earned a Bachelor's in Chemistry from West Virginia University.

O'Tar T. Norwood

The Norwood Lectureship pays tribute to O'Tar Norwood, MD, an Oklahoma physician who had a long and successful career in dermatology. At the time of writing his first book on Hair Transplant Surgery in 1973, he was Clinical Assistant Professor of Dermatology at the University of Oklahoma Medical School, USA. Amongst other things he was a Founding Member of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery and with Dr. Dow Stough he was instrumental in gathering like-minded doctors in 1992 to form the ISHRS. O'Tar was a restless thinker who brought together people and ideas to explain the MPHL process. His letters and

communications were so numerous that he started a magazine called the Hair Transplant Forum International. It grew very quickly and became so popular that everyone wanted to read it and contribute articles. Soon after, O'Tar donated the magazine to the ISHRS. Its descendant is the ever-popular Forum we read today. O'Tar continued to publish and teach at our conferences for many years. His name is etched in our history. Those who knew O'Tar fondly remember the informal moments after lectures where his wit and joy for life were wonderful to share. He would welcome all with his cheeky warm smile.

Established in 2019, the Stough Lecture honors ISHRS Co-founder Dow Stough, MD, who in the early 1990's recognized that the fractured, chaotic, and often secretive world of hair restoration needed an anchor. The founding of the ISHRS in 1993 brought order to chaos, turned competitors into colleagues, and created an educational organization that has changed the face and improved the outcomes of hair restoration throughout the world. A very well-respected dermatologist from Hot Springs, Arkansas, USA, Dr. Stough

was one of the earliest proponents of follicular unit transplantation and natural looking hairlines, and his focus on innovation and teaching is evidenced by Dow being the youngest President, Program Chair, Golden Follicle Award winner, and Manfred Lucas Award winner in ISHRS history. He is a true leader and his contagious enthusiasm has inspired and motivated many hair transplant surgeons. 



 physical or digital proof of at least 2 (two) doses or complete vaccination scheme endorsed by the
 WHO, EMA and FDA, equal to or greater than 14 days after the last dose.
- 2. Non-vaccinated or partially vaccinated travelers will be required to present a negative COVID-19 PCR or antigen test taken no more than 72 hours prior to their arrival time in Panama. If a test is not possible within that time frame, a COVID-19 rapid test will be mandated at the airport and the traveler will have to cover the costs of said test (\$50 USD).
 - If the results are positive, the traveler will be placed under a mandatory 5-day minimum quarantine in a hotel. The cost of the stay must be fully covered by the traveler.
- ALL travelers are required to present their completed Electronic Health Affidavit (in physical or digital form) to their airline or carrier BEFORE boarding to Panama. Register and fill out your Health Affidavit at https://viajes.panamadigital.gob.pa/

RETURNING TO YOUR HOME COUNTRY

We highly recommend each attendee check re-entry policy with their airline and home country embassy.

- COVID-19 testing is available for Departing Passengers from Tocumen International Airport (PTY).
- The center is open from 5:00AM to 9:00PM.
- The cost of the COVID-19 rapid test is \$50 USD and the result takes around 40 minutes.
- The service is first come, first served, so all passengers who want to get a test are encouraged to arrive with enough time before their flight.

QUARANTINE REQUIREMENTS

Travelers who test positive for COVID can be required to quarantine for up to 10 days.

Due to increased instances of mandatory detention by health authorities, we do not recommend same day airport testing.

*PLEASE NOTE: Requirements change rapidly. It is your responsibility to confirm requirements with your airline, accommodations, and other events/activities before travel.

PROOF OF VACCINATION Proof of vaccination is not required for attendance at the ISHRS World Congress. However, the Attestation completed during the registration process, which states attendees meet the requirements to enter Panama and will comply with all rules and regulations, is required. In any case, it is recommended to carry proof of vaccination in Panama— a physical copy, digital copy, or both.

COVID-19 TESTING IN PANAMA COVID-19 testing is no longer widely available in Panama. Attendees are encouraged to travel with self-administered tests to monitor themselves. Hotel staff can help to arrange COVID-19 tests if necessary.


